FLASH TO:

40 INT. SAM KASSMEYER'S HOUSE/LIVING ROOM - DAY (FLASHBACK) 40  
FLASH -- back to the PAST. Foyet punches Kassmeyer again.

FOYET  
This is no time to be a hero.

KASSMEYER  
Kill me. I don't give a damn. I'm not telling you anything.

FOYET  
Oh, you're not gonna get away that easy. I want you alive to tell Agent Hotchner that, because of him, his family is dead.

"Medic"  
I'm \*Read #1  
and #2  
as one  
character

As we HEAR --

HOTCH (V.O.)  
Sam, can you hear me?

And we're back in --

BACK TO:

41 INT. SAM KASSMEYER'S HOUSE/LIVING ROOM - DAY 41

Present. TWO PARAMEDICS rush in (these are NOT the paramedics that we met in the teaser). They clear a path as --

REID  
Three gunshot wounds to the leg and he was beaten badly.

-- And Medic #1 heads straight to Kassmeyer. Hotch is over him.

START →  
HOTCH  
Sam, can you hear me?

MEDIC #1  
You need to clear out of the way.

Hotch moves away. Medic #2 begins speaking to Kassmeyer.

MEDIC #2 (CON'D)  
Can you tell me your name?

HOTCH

MEDIC #2

(to Medic 1)

Kassmeyer manages to shake his head no. Medic #1 brings a c-collar. Medic #2 puts it on while Medic #1 puts a blood pressure cuff on the arm.

MEDIC #2 (cont'd)

Tachy at 95, equal breath sounds, BP 114 over 82.

Call ahead to the ER. Tell them we're gonna need a trauma surgeon standing by.
